



TOLL RESTRICTION

Restrict access from your telephone to the toll network.




How it works:

Allows you to restrict access to toll calling other than 800-type numbers. The service assigns you a four-digit Personal Identification Number (PIN). The PIN is used to bypass the toll restriction. Since distribution of the PIN is controlled by you, the customer, you remain responsible for all toll charges to your number even if toll restriction service is in operation.

How to use:

-  1. Call the telephone office and have them set your number up for Toll Restriction, establishing the initial PIN.
-  2. Lift the handset and listen for the dial tone.
3. Dial the telephone number you wish to call.
4. When prompted, enter your pin number.

To change your pin number:

-  1. Lift the handset and listen for dial tone.
2. Dial 360-278-0009.
-  3. When prompted, enter your current pin number.
-  4. Follow the voice instructions.
